

Municipal Energy Usage for Calendar Year 2010

The City of McAllen purchases natural gas from Texas Gas Service. In Calendar Year 2010, the City purchased a total of 7,720 thousand cubic feet (MCF) of natural gas.

The City purchases electricity from Direct Energy, StarTex Power and Magic Valley Electric Co-op. In calendar year 2010, the City purchased a total of 63,585,495 kilowatt hours.

The City purchases water from the City of McAllen Water Utility, City of Hidalgo, City of Mission and Sharyland Water Supply Corp. In calendar year 2010, the City purchased a total of 294,050,000 gallons of water for municipal use.

The Total cost of natural gas, electricity and water purchased by the City for municipal use in calendar year 2010 is \$ 8,627,463.92.
