Raceway Thunder Instructions

Ladies and Gentlemen: Start Your Engines!!!! Good morning and thank you for participating in our inaugural Raceway Thunder competition as part of the Golden Age Olympics. The rules for this event are quite simple: be the fastest over the course over two time trials. Here's how it will work.

- 1) Each competitor will drive two heats in two different cars.
- 2) A heat consists of 4 timed laps. Once you enter the track, you will be given a warm-up lap to get up to full speed. Your overall time will start and stop at the designated point on the track.
- 3) At the completion of your timed laps, circle the course a final time and enter the pits to allow the next driver to board the vehicle.
- 4) There will be two cars on the track at one time, usually. We will do our best to space them to insure no interference takes place. Therefore, on your final lap please keep a good pace and be aware of the other competitor on the track. It will be the discretion of the judges to determine if interference has taken place.
- 5) Drivers will do both their heats in consecutive order. After driving your first heat, stay in the pits to take your second time trial in the other vehicle.
