To the Registered Voters of the City of McAllen, Texas:

Notice is hereby given of a General City Election to be held on Saturday, May 9, 2009 for the following purpose:

- a) To elect One Mayor (At-large) and Three Commissioners: One for each of the Single Member Districts One, Two and Three, respectively, to the Board of Commissioners of McAllen, Texas; and
- b) To elect Two (2) Trustees: One for each of the Places One and Four, respectively, to the McAllen Public Utilities Board.


