

## WAYS TO KEEP THE LIGHTS ON AND PHONES WORKING

Some utility providers are offering to stop cutting people off for nonpayment. A number of large internet companies have agreed not to terminate residential or small business customers who can't pay their bills: AT&T, Comcast, Cox, RCN, Sprint, T-Mobile and Verizon. It is not yet clear whether companies want customers to call to invoke this relief and provide proof or whether they will offer it automatically to everyone.
