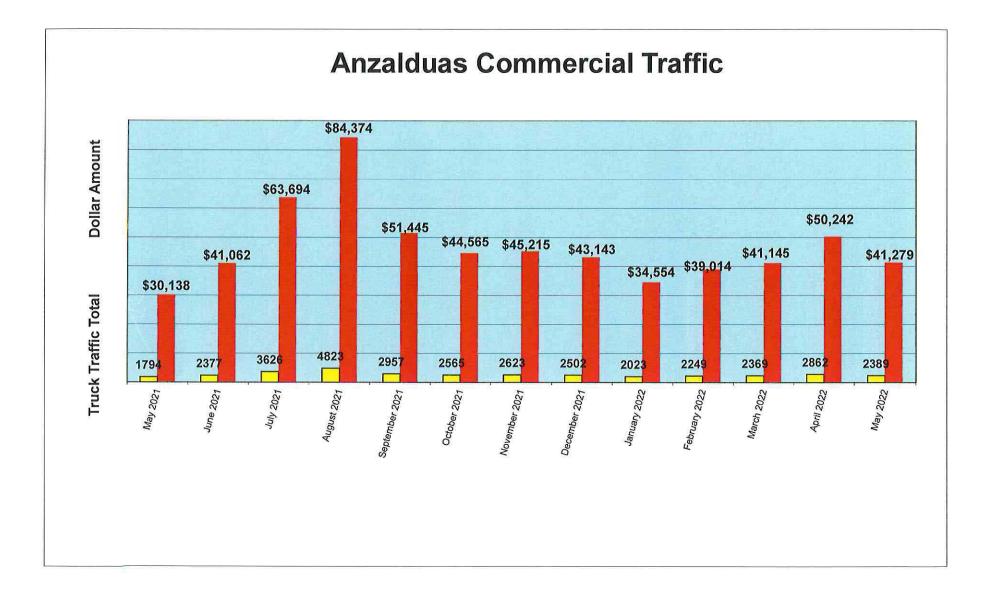

Comparison with Prior Year

Net income, as reflected on page 3, for the month of April is \$232,541 or a 155.35% increase compared to last year. Toll Revenues for the month were \$403,639 or a 59% increase compared to last year. Expenses were \$184,512 or an 8% increase compared to last year.

Comparison with Budget

Net income, as reflected on page 4, for the month of April is \$353,439. Net income was \$185,533 better than budget for the month. Toll revenues were \$403,639 for the month. Toll revenues were \$151,889 more than budget for the month. April's monthly expenses were \$63,614 or (\$174,701) less than budget for the month.
