Net income before depreciation, as reflected on page 3, for the month of September is \$370,321-(\$53,353) less than the prior month. Toll revenues were \$396,043 for the month -(\$12,944) less than last month. Expenses were \$241,489 for the month -\$21,159 more than the prior month.

## Comparison with Budget

Net income before depreciation, as reflected on page 5, for the month of September is \$370,321and \$7,876,045 for the year. Toll revenues were \$396,043 for the month and \$7,845,234 year to date. Toll revenues were (\$578,225) less than budget for the month and (3,845,983) less than budget year to date. Net income was (\$554,762) less than budget for the month and (\$3,225,207) less than budget year to date. Administrative and operating expenses were \$241,489 for the month and \$2,888,716 year to date. Administrative and operating expenses were (\$16,975) less than budget for the month and (\$212,608) less than budget year to date.
