OPERATING RESULTS
For the Month Ending May 31, 2026

Comparison with Prior Year

Net income, as reflected on page 3, for the month of May is \$933,778 or an 8.14% increase compared to last year. Toll revenues were \$1,076,930 for the month, 9.58% increase over last year same time. Expenses were \$440,343 or a (0.87%) decrease compared to last year.

Comparison with Budget

Revenues over expenses, as reflected on page 5, for the month of May are \$991,136. These revenues over expenses were \$89,154 more than budget for the month. Total operating revenues were \$1,350,479 for the month. These total operating revenues were \$105,663 more than budget for the month. Administrative and operating expenses were \$382,986 for the month. Administrative and operating expenses were \$30,818 more than budget for the month.

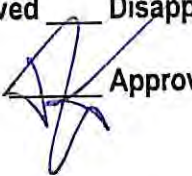
