Full Phase 1 Re-Opening Commitment

As a responsible vendor in the McAllen Business Community, we hereby affirm our commitment to a safe community and to protecting our valuable customers by agreeing to comply with the Governor's Executive Order GA-18, the specific guidelines spelled out in The Governor's Report to Open Texas (Texans Helping Texans – April 27, 2020), and all other current and future applicable regulations and guidelines, including, but not limited to:

1. Protecting our employees by:

- a. Checking on their well-being and health before every work shift by screening employees for illness or possible exposure or COVID-19 symptoms
- b. Providing them with Personal Protective Equipment and training as appropriate, including washbasins and soap, hand sanitizer, face masks, nitrile gloves, and face shields (all as appropriate)
- c. Asking our customers to kindly observe proper hygiene etiquette when interacting with our employees

2. Protecting our customers by:

- a. Washing and/or sanitizing our hands on a regular basis
- b. Monitoring social distancing within stores
- c. Sanitizing frequently used surfaces such as doorknobs, handles, push plates, shopping carts, tables, chairs, restrooms, and fuel pump handles on a regular and frequent basis
- d. Disinfecting items that come into contact with customers
- e. Making hand sanitizer, disinfecting wipes, soap and water, or similar disinfectant readily available to both employees and customers
- f. Placing readily visible signage at the business to remind everyone of best hygiene practices
