

## 4<sup>th</sup> Street at Tulip Avenue Drainage Improvements

Update: 10/27/2025



As part of the City of McAllen’s ongoing efforts to improve drainage infrastructure citywide, the 4th Street at Tulip Avenue Drainage project will enhance our local storm infrastructure and improve overall water management in the area. Construction activity will take place at alley intersections between 5th Street and 4th Street, north of Sunflower Avenue, to install new stormwater infrastructure.

**Update:** Construction contract was awarded to RDH Site & Concrete from Palmview, TX. Crews are anticipated to start in November. Anticipated completion date is December 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2025.

### What to Expect:

- **Construction Activity:** Drainage infrastructure improvements (new grate inlet and concrete apron at alley)
- **Alley:** Alley will be closed in construction area.
- **Working Hours:** Work will generally take place Monday through Friday, from 7:00 AM to 5:00 PM. Some weekend work may be necessary.
- **Traffic Impact:** Minor impacts. Local access to homes and businesses will be maintained whenever possible.
- **Noise and Dust:** Minor dust and noise are anticipated during construction.
