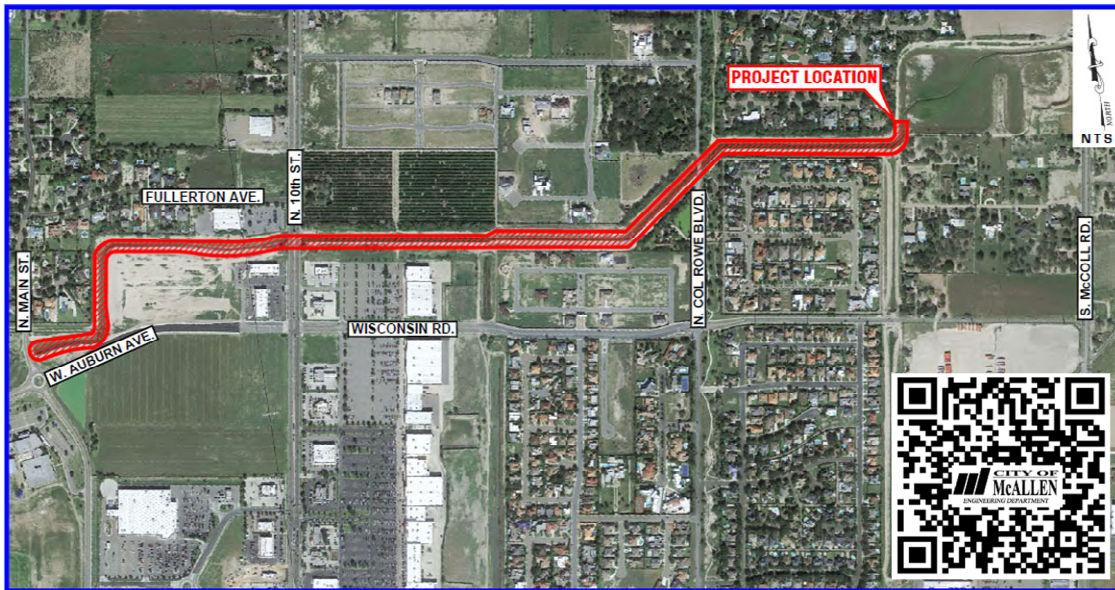


McAllen Lateral Channel Improvements

Construction update

As the City of McAllen continues improving drainage throughout the city, the McAllen Lateral Channel Improvements project enhances stormwater conveyance and capacity to our system.

Update: Channel improvements continue between N. 10th Street and 2nd Street. Crews working on drainage infrastructure at 10th street ROW drainage outfalls and irrigation line improvements. Excavation and grading activities east of 2nd Street have commenced.

What to Expect:

- **Construction Activity:** Excavation and grading activities along the channel. (i.e. excavation equipment, heavy machinery, trucks).
- **Working Hours:** Work will generally take place Monday through Friday, from 7:00 AM to 5:00 PM. Some weekend work may be necessary.
- **Traffic Impact:** Local access to homes and businesses will be maintained whenever possible; periodic lane closures, detours, and construction equipment in the area as construction progresses.
- **Noise and Dust:** Increased noise and dust during construction along project extents; mitigation measures ongoing (watering/sweeping). We appreciate your patience and understanding.
