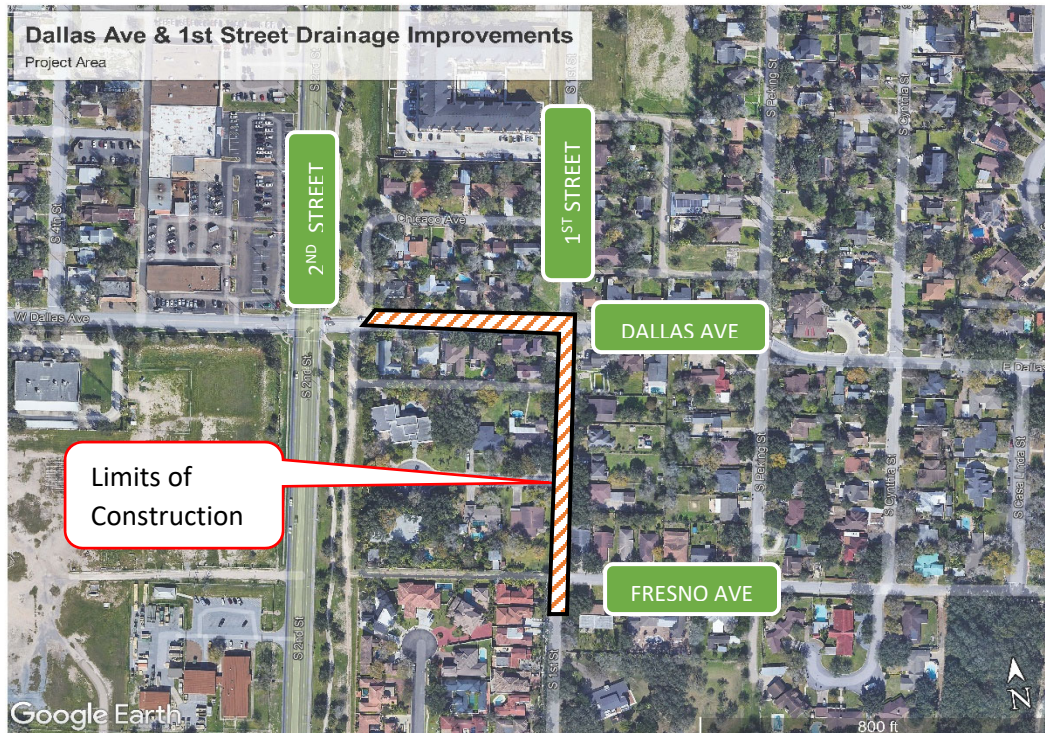


Dallas Avenue & 1st Street Drainage Improvements

As part of the City of McAllen's ongoing efforts to improve drainage infrastructure citywide, the Dallas Avenue at 1st Street drainage project will enhance our local storm infrastructure and improve overall water management in the area. New storm sewer infrastructure will be installed. Limits of construction will be along Dallas Avenue and 1st Street, as shown above.

Update: Installation of storm sewer infrastructure along Dallas Avenue are in place. Preparations for pavement repair along trench extents ongoing. Crews are working on new curb/gutter along S. 1st Street between Dallas and Fresno.

What to Expect:

- **Construction Activity:** Installation of new drainage infrastructure (Storm pipe, curb inlets, manholes, curb/gutter, valley gutters)
- **Public Utilities Services:** Expect interruptions to water, sewer, garbage, and brush as construction moves along roadways.
- **Working Hours:** Work will generally take place Monday through Friday, from 7:00 AM to 5:00 PM. Some weekend work may be necessary.
- **Traffic Impact:** Periodic lane closures, construction equipment in the area. Local access to homes and businesses will be maintained whenever possible.
- **Noise and Dust:** Dust and noise during construction; mitigation measures (watering/sweeping) ongoing.
