Main & Jay Drainage Improvements Update: 09/05/2025



As the City of McAllen continues improving drainage throughout the city, the Main & Jay Drainage project will enhance our local storm infrastructure and improve overall water management in the area. Construction work is anticipated to move east of Main Street to install the storm water infrastructure along Lark Avenue and will eventually end at Jay Avenue and 11th Street.

Update: All storm sewer infrastructure has been installed, and pavement has been place. We will be coordinating with the contractor to conduct a project walk-through to address project deficiencies.

What to Expect:

- **Construction Activity:** Crews will be on site addressing project deficiencies.
- **City Right-of-Way/Adjacent areas**: Evaluation to restore impacted areas to pre-existing conditions.
- **Working Hours:** Work will generally take place Monday through Friday, from 7:00 AM to 5:00 PM. Some weekend work may be necessary.
- **Traffic Impact:** Minor impacts. Local access to homes and businesses will be maintained whenever possible.
- Noise and Dust: Minor dust and noise are anticipated during remaining work.
