## McAllen Readies to Welcome Thousands for 13th Annual McAllen Marathon Scott Crane Run Presented by H E B Helping Here

*Official Boston Marathon Qualifier takes place this weekend*

The City of McAllen is preparing to welcome thousands of runners and spectators for one of South Texas' premier running events, the **13th Annual McAllen Marathon Scott Crane Run presented by H E B Helping Here**, taking place Saturday, January 17, 2026.

City leaders, event organizers, and sponsors gathered earlier today at the McAllen Convention Center to highlight the continued growth and community impact of the marathon, which has become a nationally recognized event since its inaugural race in 2013.

“In just over a decade, the **McAllen Marathon Scott Crane Run** has grown into a signature event that reflects who we are as a city,” said City Manager Isaac J. Tawil. “This marathon is about more than running. It is about health, wellness, personal achievement, and community connection. Whether you are crossing the finish line, cheering from the sidelines, or volunteering along the course, there is a place for everyone in this event.”

Since its inception, the McAllen Marathon has attracted runners from more than 17 states and three countries, drawing participants to a flat, fast, USATF certified course that also serves as an official Boston Marathon qualifier. The event honors the legacy of the late Scott Crane, a former McAllen City Commissioner and passionate advocate for community fitness, parks, and quality of life.

“What began as a vision to promote health and active living has grown into something truly special,” said Chief U.S. District Judge Randy Crane. “Naming the marathon in Scott’s honor ensures his passion for fitness and for McAllen continues to inspire runners of all ages and abilities. Each year, this race brings people together from near and far, and that is exactly what Scott believed in.”

All races start and finish at the McAllen Convention Center, located at 700 Convention Center Boulevard. Races begin at 7:00 a.m. and include the full marathon, half marathon, relay marathon, 10K, 5K, and the Kids Final Mile.

- **\$120 – Full Marathon**
- **\$100 – Half Marathon**
- **\$330 – Relay Marathon**
- **\$45 – 10K – SOLD OUT**
- **\$35 – 5K**

The **McAllen Marathon Health and Wellness Expo** will take place Friday, January 16, 2026, from 4:00 p m. to 8:00 p m. at the McAllen Convention Center Exhibit Hall. Runners may pick up race packets and explore vendor booths focused on health, fitness, and wellness.

Following the race, runners and spectators are invited to the **EXTRA Mile Post Race Celebration** at Oval Park at the Convention Center. The celebration will feature food booths, wellness vendors, and family friendly activities.
