## Suspects wanted in bank fraud scheme

McAllen Police Officers responded to a report of suspicious activity at a financial institution on the 10 block of South Broadway on October 27, 2025. Bank employees reported a suspicious transaction to police. McAllen Investigators determined fraudulent identifying information was presented by an individual in an attempt to cash or deposit a check. Investigators identified **Trevon Terrell Harris** as the suspect.

The investigation revealed multiple individuals visited various financial institutions in the McAllen area in attempts to deposit checks using fictitious identifying information. **Kareem Kalil Gordon** is subsequently identified in this investigation as participating in this activity. Use of multiple fraudulent or fictitious identification cards are suspected in this case. Use of this information granted access to funds from an account.

A magistrate in the McAllen Municipal Court determined probable cause was established to issue warrants of arrest for **Trevon Terrell Harris** and **Kareem Kalil Gordon**. Trevon Terrell Harris faces arrest for four (4) counts of Tampering with a Governmental Record, a State Jail Felony. Kareem Kalil Gordon faces arrest for Tampering with a Governmental Record, a State Jail Felony, and Theft, a State Jail Felony.

**Trevon Terrell Harris** is described as 23 years of age, approximately 6' 02" in height, approximately 185 pounds, black hair, and brown eyes. **Trevon Terrell Harris'** last known address is in Spring, Texas. **Kareem Kalil Gordon** is described as 35 years of age, approximately 5' 07" in height, approximately 180 pounds, black hair, and brown eyes. **Kareem Kalil Gordon's** last known address is in Missouri City, Texas.
